was born in 1978 in Seoul, South Korea. From 2000 to 2006 he studied voice at the Seoul National University with Prof. Philip Kang (Bachelor of Music).

In 2007 he came to Germany and continued his studies at the Hochschule für Musik und Theater München with Prof. Gabriele Fuchs (diploma in 2008).

In 2006 he made his debut in the title role of "Don Giovanni" at the Seoul National University, as well as at the Hyundai Arts Center in Ulsan and in Phang.

2007 he sang Simone in a "Gianni Schicchi" production at the Prinzregententheater München with the Munich Radio Orchestra and the Bayerische Theaterakademie August Everding. At the same venue he sang the role of Conte Robinson in "Il matrimonio segreto" by Cimarosa in 2008 and Schaunard in "La Bohème" in 2009.

In 2009 he was invited as a guest to sing at the Staatstheater Darmstadt.

In February 2009 he won a 1st prize at the International Voice Competition Schlossoper Haldensein in Chur, Switzerland and was chosen to sing Escamillo in "Carmen" at the Schlossoper Haldenstein and at the Tonhalle Zürich in August 2009.

During the season 2009/2010, Ilhun Jung is a member of the "Young Ensemble" of the prestigious Semperoper Dresden.
